Conveyance Allowance

A Conveyance Allowance is paid to a parent/carer to assist in costs of driving their child to and from school or a pick- up location.

Parents/Carers should note the following regarding conveyance allowance:

- SBS will determine which form of transport assistance will be offered to a Parent/Carer.
- No payment is made for travel prior to the school term in which the Conveyance Allowance is approved. For example: if a conveyance allowance is approved from Term 2, 2013, a claim made for Term 1, 2013 or any other previous period will not be considered.
- It is not paid to a parent/carer who drops their child off at school on the way to work.
